The Georgia Senior Hunger Summit is one step in a larger plan to combat senior hunger in Georgia. This unprecedented event will accomplish two things:

1. Raise awareness of how deeply senior hunger affects Georgians
2. Examine underlying factors that accompany the problem.

A multidisciplinary field of experts, legislators and community representatives will gather at the Summit to tackle tough issues.

The Department of Human Services (DHS) Division of Aging Services will document Summit discussions, share highlights and form a diverse statewide work group charged with developing Georgia's first State Plan to Address Senior Hunger.

September's Summit activities will culminate in Georgia's observation of the 2016 World Food Day Celebration. During World Food Day, advocates throughout Georgia will join together to bring awareness to international food policy and focus on the close-to-home goal of improving food access and quality for Georgia's older adults.
